TODAY'S READINGS

First Reading: Acts 14:21-27 **Paul and Barnabas proclaim the good news in many places.**

Responsorial Psalm: 145:8-13 I WILL BLESS YOUR NAME FOR EVER, MY KING AND MY GOD.

Second Reading: Rev 21:1-5a John describes his vision of a new heaven and a new earth.

Gospel Reading: Jn 13:31-33a, 34-35 Jesus gives his disciples a new commandment: love one another.

Reflection

Beloved, in today's Gospel we hear words spoken by Jesus before his death and Resurrection. Jesus, here, is teaching at the Last Supper. It is difficult to choose to love when faced with hatred and anger. Jesus tells the disciples that all will know that they are his disciples because of the love they show for one another. This description of the early Christian community will be repeated in the Acts of the Apostles: "See how they love one another." Christian love is the hallmark of Christianity. We see it lived in the witness of the martyrs. We see it in the example of the lives of the saints. 


PRAYER FOR GOD'S INTERVENTION IN OUR LAND CASE
