TODAY'S READINGS

First Reading: Sir 35:12-14,16 God hears the prayer of the poor.

Responsorial Psalm: Ps 34:2-3,17-19,23

THE LOWLY ONE CALLED, AND THE LORD HEARD HIM.

Second Reading: 2Tim 4:6-8,16-18 Paul perseveres in faith, confident that God will rescue him.

Gospel Reading: Lk 18:9-14

Jesus tells the parable of the proud Pharisee who prayed from his self-importance and the tax collector who prayed humbly.

REFLECTION

We hear today the parable of the Pharisee and tax collector. Tax collectors were collaborators with the Roman authorities in a system that allowed the tax collectors to enrich their own pockets by charging in excess of the defined taxes.

The Pharisees were a religious sect whose life of holiness separated them from sinners. If anyone would be a model for prayer, a Pharisee was a likely candidate. Yet, in this parable, Jesus offers the humility of the tax collector as a model for the prayer of a disciple. The parable reminds us that when we pray, we must remember our need for God in our lives. We must approach God with humility and sincerity in heart. If we are too full of ourselves, there is too little room for God's grace to work in us. Lord, help us to approach you in all humility. Rev. MARKS OF THE CHURCH

<u>HOLY</u>

If the Church is the Bride of Christ, the Body of Christ, and the Temple of the Holy Spirit, then the Church is, by necessity, not only united as one but is also holy. It's not possible to be united to Christ so intimately and, at the same time, to lack holiness. In fact, the more we sin, the less a member of the Church we become. So, if we are to become full living members of the Church, then we must individually become holy. We must become saints!

The heart of holiness is charity. Therefore, insofar as each one of us grows in charity, we also grow in holiness. Saint Thérèse of Lisieux is quoted in the Catechism in coming to this discovery:

If the Church was a body composed of different members, it couldn't lack the noblest of all; it must have a Heart, and a Heart BURNING WITH LOVE. And I realized that this love alone was the true motive force which enabled the other members of the Church to act; if it ceased to function, the Apostles would forget to preach the gospel, the Martyrs would refuse to shed their blood. LOVE, IN FACT, IS THE VOCATION WHICH INCLUDES ALL OTHERS; IT'S A UNIVERSE OF ITS OWN, COMPRISING ALL TIME AND SPACE—IT'S ETERNAL! (CCC #826)

The story Saint Thérèse tells is a powerful one in her spiritual autobiography. She shares that she was desirous of fulfilling so many different missions within the Church. She longed to be a missionary, pondered what it would be like to be a priest, and continued to seek what her role was within the Church, within the Body of Christ. One day it hit her. She discovered her mission was to be the heart of Christ, the heart of the Church. And, in being the heart, she was to be love. And in being love, she was to be all things.

Now this is holiness! And it is this discovery of being love and living love that make the Church truly holy!

Our Blessed Mother is the supreme model of holiness in the Church because she is perfectly filled with love. Therefore, she is perfectly holy.

PRAYER FOR GOD'S INTERVENTION IN OUR LAND CASE



Then, the speaker asked the participants to go back in the room and pick up one balloon at random, look at the name, and return it to its owner. Within minutes, everyone had been reunited with their original balloon.

The speaker then told the group, "This is what it's like when people are frantically searching for their own happiness in life. People push others aside to get the things that they want that they believe will bring them happiness. However, our happiness actually lies in helping other people and working together as a community." The Moral:

You will get your happiness if you help other people find theirs. The Dalai Lama says, "If you want to be happy, practice compassion." Helping others makes us happy because it gives us a sense of purpose. In fact, a study from the London School of Economics found that the more you help other people, the happier you will be.
