TODAY'S READINGS

First Reading: Is 7:10-14: Ahaz proclaims the sign that the Lord will give: a virgin shall give birth to a son, Emmanuel.

Responsorial Psalm: Ps 24:1-2, 3-4, 5-6,7c.10b

LET THE LORD ENTER, HE IS THE KING OF GLORY.

Second Reading: Rom 1:1-7: Paul greets the community at Rome and declares himself a servant of Christ Jesus.

Gospel Reading: Mt 1:18-24: An angel appears to Joseph, directing him to take Mary as his wife and telling him that the child she will bear will be called Emmanuel.

REFLECTION

Today's gospel is a revelation of the mystery of the incarnation. The readings point to the fact that the nativity is a mystery beyond human comprehension. The prophesy – the virgin shall conceive and bear a son – was given by the Prophet Isaiah. But today the readings emphasize the difficulty in comprehension even for the righteous. Joseph and Mary, though righteous in the sight of God, were unable to comprehend the mystery of 'conception by the Holy Spirit'. It took the intervention of the angel of the Lord for Joseph to take Mary home as his wife. According to Paul, this mystery calls us to the obedience of faith. The obedience of faith is what will connect us to *EMMANUEL*, the God that is with us! (Fr. Anthony Ekpunobi)

10 THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT THE ADVENT SEASON - Contd

7. How Are Churches Decorated During Advent?

The General Instruction of the Roman Missal notes:

During Advent the floral decoration of the altar should be marked by a moderation suited to the character of this time of year, without expressing in anticipation the full joy of the Nativity of the Lord. During Lent it is forbidden for the altar to be decorated with flowers. Exceptions, however, are *Laetare* Sunday (Fourth Sunday of Lent), Solemnities, and Feasts.

8. How Is Music Performed During Advent?

The General Instruction of the Roman Missal notes:

In Advent the use of the organ and other musical instruments should be marked by a moderation suited to the character of this time of year, without expressing in anticipation the full joy of the Nativity of the Lord. In Lent the playing of the organ and musical instruments is allowed only in order to support the singing. Exceptions, however, are *Laetare* Sunday (Fourth Sunday of Lent), Solemnities, and Feasts.

9. Is the Gloria Said or Sung During Advent?

Neither. The General Instruction of the Roman Missal provides: [The *Gloria* or "Glory to God in the highest"] is sung or said on Sundays **outside Advent** and Lent, and also on Solemnities and Feasts, and at particular celebrations of a more solemn character.

10. What Private Devotions Can We Use to Grow Closer to God During Advent?

There are a variety of private devotions that the Church has recognized for use during Advent. The most famous is the Advent Wreath.


We humbly beseech you to help us win back our Land in this dispute. Save us from violence, discord and confusion and the evil plans of our adversaries.

6. Set financial goals: Decide what you are saving for, the timeline involved and how to spread the cost. For example, if you want to have ghc2000 by the end of the year for Christmas celebrations. We have three more months to go. So, that's 2000/3. That will give you 670 cedis a month. So, you have to save from now till Dec, ghc670.

Use this method to plan for the future.

- 7. Try the 70:20:10 principle: Some financial advisors advise using 70% of your savings to cover your expenses, while you Save 20% and use the 10% as tithe (if you believe in it) or investments (if you prefer this option). That is a simple way of proportioning your money. But will require financial discipline to contain your expenses.
- **8. Try Investments:** While we can work now and earn money, what about the future? We need to plan for the future. One way to do that is to invest wisely. Take time to research the different investment offers on the market, and choose one that best fits you and is safe.
- **9.** Pay yourself: Yes, pay yourself. That is most useful for those running businesses. Learn how to pay yourself every month. That helps you separate business funds from personal funds. Also, to take good care of yourself.
- 10. Subscribe to an Insurance package: This is very beneficial during disasters, health failures, deaths or accidents. You can use the money you will receive from the claims to satisfy a lot of the expenses. And this will go
