#### Reflection

Today's Gospel is the conclusion of the instructions and consolations that we have heard Jesus offering to his disciples during the past few weeks. In this passage, Jesus summarizes both the costs of discipleship and its rewards. The conditions of discipleship outlined in Matthew's Gospel may appear harsh. Yet they underline for us a truth—choosing anything with one's whole heart has consequences. Choosing life with Christ means that every relationship we have must be understood from a new perspective. Matthew also outlines the reward of hospitality offered to Jesus' followers. In today's Gospel, Jesus explains the difficulties of discipleship, yet reveals that those who welcome the disciples have also welcomed him. We see also the importance of hospitality in the Christian life. To welcome another in Jesus' name is to extend hospitality to Jesus himself. We have many opportunities in our daily life to reach out to others, to be a welcoming presence and a sign of God's love.

#### THE FUNCTIONS OF THE SACRAMENTS -

#### Continued from last week

#### 2. The function of the sacrament as ecclesiological

The understanding of the ecclesial function of the sacrament, can be seen in what the Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches, that;

The sacraments are of the Church in a double sense that; they are "by her and for her." They are "by the church" for she is the sacrament of Christ's action at work in her through the mission of the Holy Spirit. They are "for the church" in the sense that, 'the sacraments make the Church' since they manifest and communicate to men, above all in the Eucharist, the mystery of communion with God, who is love, One in three persons.

The sense that the sacraments are "for the church", reflects or affirms Augustine's view that no people can be united without being brought together by the sharing of a sacrament. Without the sacraments, there can be no gathering of people, no faith, no unity. The Second Vatican Council explained rightly that the sacraments presuppose faith; calling individuals to faith, gathering them into one people, thus, building up the Body of Christ. The communion and unity of the Church is therefore derived from the sacraments. The sense that the sacraments are "by the church", reflects the view that the church is the "fundamental sacrament" not in the sense that the church is the source of the sacraments and its effects, but that, it is only through the church that one participates in Christ's redemption, which is the source of grace.

The sacraments therefore, function as event that calls men into an ecclesial community, and also, it is only through its salvific function that the church becomes an "effective community of salvation."

### CHRIST IS THE PURPOSE OF THE SACRAMENT (CHRISTOCENTRIC)

Critically analyzed, the sacraments have but one basic function, that is, to confer grace for the salvation of man, deducing first from the narratives of the institution of the Eucharist "this is my blood of the covenant, which will be shed on behalf of many for the forgiveness of sins" (Matt.

#### SHORT TERM GAIN CAN CAUSE LONG-TERM PAIN

There are two laws that you fall victim to when you fail to practice self-discipline.

The first Law is called the "Law of Unintended Consequences." This law states that "the unintended consequences of an action can be far worse than the intended consequences of that behavior because of a lack of long-term thinking."

The second is the "Law of Perverse consequences," which says that "a short-term action aimed at immediate gratification can lead to perverse, or the opposite, consequences from those at which it was aimed."

For example, you might make an investment of time, money or emotion with the desire and intent to be better off and happier as a result. But because you acted without carefully thinking or doing your homework, the consequences of your behavior turned out to be far worse than if you had done nothing at all. Every person has had this experience, and usually more than once.
