TODAY'S READINGS

First Reading: Mal 1:14b-2:2b, 8-10: Through the prophet Malachi, God judges the priests of Israel and calls them to be more faithful to the Covenant.

Responsorial Psalm: Ps 131:1-3 KEEP MY SOUL IN PEACE AT YOUR SIDE, O LORD.

Second Reading: **1Thes 2:7b-9, 13:** Paul gives thanks to God for the way in which the Thessalonians received the word of God.

Gospel Reading: Mt 23:1-12: Jesus warns against following the example of the scribes and the Pharisees and teaches that those who would be great must be servants.

REFLECTION

Beloved in Christ, in our quest to build our spiritual life as Christians, we may come across people who will definitely portray themselves as very good spiritual leaders. We should not be quick to acclaim, accept, or follow anyone who tends to portray himself as a spiritual leader or director, a Christian or spiritual father, or a teacher of faith. Some are often deceptive and tend to live double lives because they do not practice what they teach. This is a similar admonishment Jesus Christ gave to the crowds in the gospel of today (Matthew 23:1–12), in relation to the Pharisees. He tells them to focus on obeying and practicing the laws taught by the Pharisees; however, they should be careful not to follow in their footsteps. Sometimes it seems obvious that the deeds of these teachers of faith in the law, spiritual leaders, and spiritual fathers are accepted by God. It is not always the case, and if care is not taken, we may end up losing our faith by following their deeds. Remember, they may exercise the offices, but they do not possess this authority; God, our Father, and His Son Jesus hold this sole authority: hence, we should always look up to them

PRAYERS OF THE FAITHFUL – Lord hear our prayer

The response to the prayers of the faithful usually is "lord, hear our prayers," although other responses may be used at times. When we address the "Lord," it is God we are summoning. Another way of phrasing "Lord, hear our prayer" is "God, listen to what we are asking."

We address God out of the belief that He cares about us. Christians believe that God is intensely interested in their lives. The God we believe in acts in the events of our lives, and desires that we be in relationship with Him. We have only to remember our lord Jesus Christ's example. He has perfectly revealed God to us. Anything we believe about God is revealed perfectly by Jesus because Jesus is God. This is why the liturgy of the Word is so important. The scriptures that are read during Mass remind us again of how Jesus has revealed what God is really like.

People constantly came to Jesus requesting help during His earthly life. He ascended into heaven they continued to come to his disciples (Acts of the Apostles), who continued to do the same works that Jesus had done because He was now living in each of them.

Through our baptism, Jesus lives in us. But we must die to ourselves so that His power may operate in our lives. As you hear the Prayers of the Faithful, make them yours by responding with a sense of urgency and faith that the Lord will hear our prayer. We address these prayers through our Lord Jesus Christ, confident that He will present them to the Father.
